- Three workers' rights

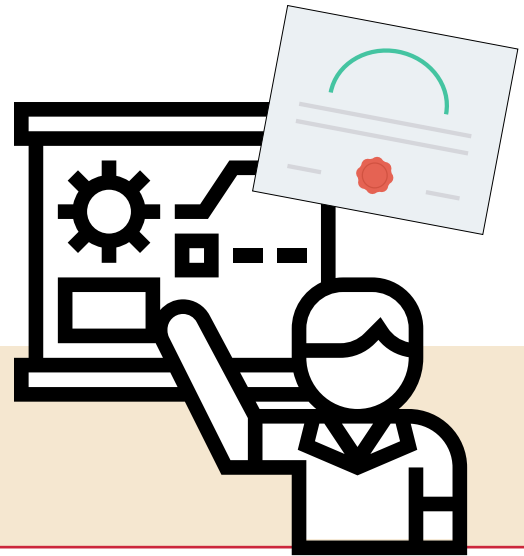
